1. Board Members

Board members shared their experiences at Back to School Night.

2. Superintendent

Dr. Meyer shared that since the last Board meeting:

- On August 14, the district had a wonderful kick-off (with all Trustees in attendance.
- Dr. Meyer acknowledged teachers who achieved permanent status.
- Adult Education conducted their kick-off, where the keynote speaker was the mayor of Mountain View.
- A new elementary school in Mountain View Whisman School District was named after Mountain View High School alum, Jose Antonio Vargas, Pulitzer prize winner and advocate.
- Important upcoming dates include the Education Foundation sponsored Freshmen and new parents' coffees at Mountain View High School on September 5th, and at Los Altos High School on September 12th.
- The Education Foundation Phonathon is September 24th and 25th.
- Pep rallies were held shortly after the beginning of the school year which highlighted clubs and after school activities.
- Dr Meyer shared that MVLA will continue to monitor success rates in a-g courses, and will continue to push academic excellence.
- Lastly, Dr. Meyer thanked the Board for their support of her in her new role.

3. Spotlight

The Board of Trustees spotlighted student Emma Athey, sophomore at Mountain View High School. Ms. Athey explained that during her freshman year she observed that the intersection of Bryant and Brower was heavily trafficked by vehicles exceeding the posted speed limit and felt that action as a community was needed. Through guidance by Mountain View assistant principal, Ms. Faught, she submitted a proposal to the Mountain View Planning Department which ultimately resulted in a cross-walk at that intersection. Emma Athey thanked the Board, the city engineer and Ms. Faught, and answered questions posed by Trustees.

Superintendent Dr. Nellie Meyer administered the Oath of Office to Oliver Yu and Jackson Harnett, student Board members. Student Trustees then reported on activities and events at their schools.

President Faillace introduced the student journalists from each of the high school newspapers.
