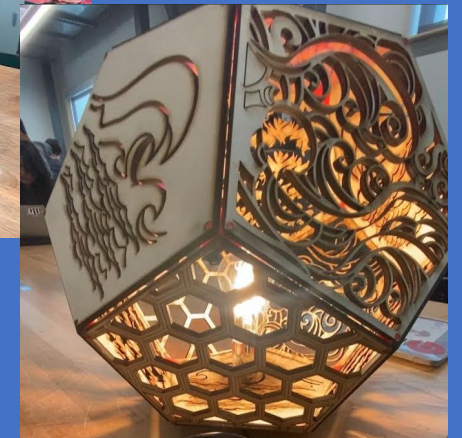
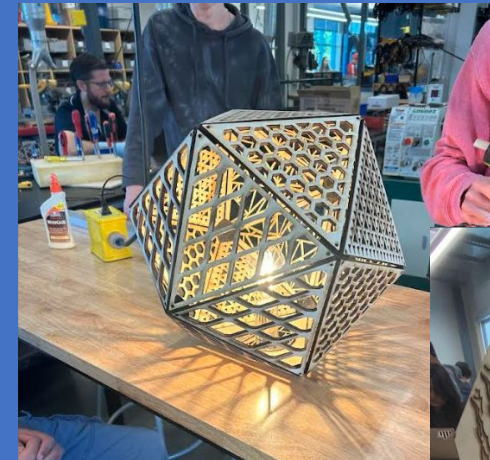
Awarded \$2500 to enhance outdoor event and learning activities
