Why would you like to be a member of the Community Advisory Council (CAC)? MVLA and the surrounding school districts in Santa Clara County have lower than average rates of inclusion for students with IEPs in California. In California rates of inclusion are lower than almost every other state in the nation. Multiple studies have shown that students with disabilities who are included for most of the day in regular classes have better outcomes academically, socially and in post-secondary opportunities. At MVLA we have a disproportionality problem of significant numbers of Latino students identified as having Specific Learning Disability and then included at lower rates in regular classrooms (39.1% in comparison to 71.2% of white students

in special education, see California Department of Education DataQuest 2023-24). We need to

make improvements in inclusion for ALL students at MVLA and in Santa Clara county.
