The plan should describe the prioritized transportation services the district will offer to its identified pupils in the 2024-25 fiscal/school year.

Transportation Services:

- 1. We currently offer no-cost VTA bus passes to students who meet the free/reduced meal egibility criteria. We work with VTA on buying bulk amount of bus passes every month so that we can give them to the students at the school site. The Buiness Office orders them and then are given to the respective campus finance office to distribute to students. Each student has to fill out an application and we have a staff person in the Business Office review the application. They compare it to the Income Eligibility Guidelines that are set by the state. If a student qualifies, they are given a monthly bus pass at no cost. A list of qualified students is given to each site and is updated when new applications are received.
- 2. The district provides different modes of transportion for students that receive Special Education services. The district is part of the six-member Silicon Valley Joint Power Transportation Authority (SVJPTA) that coordinates appropriate roundtrip transportation services for students with special needs and to transport these children safely and when such transportation is specified in the student's Individualized Education Plan (IEP). In addition, students with an IEP who are homeless and/or placed in foster home requiring transportation are provided roundtrip transportation as well. This is coordinated by the Special Education office. In addition to the JPA, we also offer monthly bus passes to these students. The IEP will specify if this is the route for the student. Homeless students recieve a bus pass automatically.
- 3. The process is the same as described in section 1. On the application, there is a section where they can list if they are receiveing any government assistance. If they let us know, they are automatically qualified to receive the monthly bus pass at no cost.
