Partners agree to:

Participate in Core Services

1. Initial Institute

Learn to implement the initiative

- Teacher Strand: Sufficient cohorts for system-wide implementation
- Instructional Leader Strand: System and site leaders, including principals, vice principals, and coaches responsible for implementation

2. Annual Spring Symposium

Robust team of system and site leaders – including principals, vice principals, coaches, and teacher leaders – continue to deepen knowledge to sustain the initiative(s)

3. Summer Leadership Seminar

A sufficiently large team, consisting of teacher leaders and instructional coaches who will facilitate ongoing learning and collaboration, build district capacity to support implementation

Commit to Implementation Support

1. Dedicate Resources for Ongoing Support

Provide regular, dedicated time with system and site leaders to take stock of initiative implementation and plan for effectively sustaining the work using *Refining Our Practice* tools.

2. Renew Annual Partnership

Commit to an annual renewal fee to maintain access to online resources – including instructional and planning tools – plus ongoing support from the E.L. Achieve team.

Honor Presenter Agreements

- 1. Use only E.L. Achieve-certified presenters for in-house institutes.
 - Refrain from allowing participants from other systems to attend institutes, either for a fee or gratis.
 - Refer requests from other systems for seats in institutes to E.L. Achieve.
- 2. Support in-house leadership through peer collaboration, consistent use of website resources and tools, and calling upon the E.L. Achieve team, as needed.

Use E.L. Achieve Materials Appropriately

- 1. Refrain from photocopying or sharing materials and electronic files without permission. This includes PowerPoint files, Google documents, handbook contents, instructional materials, and any document downloaded from or posted on the password-protected website.
 - If partners would like to post documents on the system's password-protected intranet, they may submit a written request to E.L. Achieve.
- 2. Ensure that E.L. Achieve product license keys are used only by assigned users (may include leaders, teachers, and/or students).

3. System staff may not offer services using E.L. Achieve materials at conferences or to other systems, either for a fee or gratis.

If partners would like to present at a conference using E.L. Achieve materials, they may submit a written request to E.L. Achieve.

E.L. Achieve will provide:

- 1. Comprehensive professional development for teachers and administrators to sustain system-wide implementation of Systematic ELD and/or Constructing Meaning
- 2. Digital and print resources for classroom implementation, including instructional materials, interaction tools, and student resources
- 3. Access to the E.L. Achieve app with digital products, newsletters, blogs, and continuing learning events, including webinars and annual Symposia
- 4. Website resources for all institute participants, including videos, tools, and a virtual community of educational experts and peers
- 5. Readily available, virtual technical assistance to support planning and implementation (e.g., communication and monitoring, ongoing learning sessions, problem-solving, etc.)
