Report to the Mountain View – Los Altos Union High School District Board of Trustees

As required by the statutes and bylaws of the Measure E Bond Election, the Citizen's Oversight Committee is pleased to provide our annual report to the Board of Trustees of the Mountain View – Los Altos Union High School District. Members of the Committee are Alan Cyron (Senior Citizen Organization member), Cleave Frink, Jr. (Taxpayer member), Michelle Lee (Parent & School Organization member), Joe Mitchner (Community member), Mary Ng Dooley (Business Organization member), VACANT (Parent member), and Amanda Patron (Community member).

On December 9, 2021 and August 30, 2022 the Committee met to review the current Measure E projects and to prepare the annual report to the school board. Mike Mathiesen and Omid Azizi reported that the Measure E program budget increased to \$310 million and is now 50% complete. To date, \$268M of the bonds have been sold, as a result of the third bond sale having been completed in 2022. Omid shared photos of the current construction of the MVHS Student Services, MVHS Auxiliary Gym, Freestyle Academy, and LAHS Student Services projects.


The Committee reviewed the Invoice Summary by Project reports for the period of April 1, 2021 through October 31, 2021 and November 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, over the course of the two COC meetings. The reports indicated that \$38,453,677.53 and \$36,036,389.24, respectively, in Measure E invoices have been processed within those time periods, and a total of \$155,714,138.15 has been expended since the inception of the Measure E projects. The bulk of current expenditures made were for the MVHS Student Services, MVHS Auxiliary Gym, Freestyle Academy, and LAHS Student Services projects. The Committee then reviewed the FY 2021 Financial and Performance Audit Reports, which had no exceptions noted and reported that in all significant respects, the District was in compliance.

The Committee then discussed the preparation of and approved this Annual Report to the school board.

The Committee commended the work done and progress to date on the Measure E program and looks forward to helping the District comply with fiscal oversight during the remaining bond projects.

Based on our review and observations, the Citizen's Oversight Committee finds that the District is in compliance with the requirements of Article XIII A, Section 1(b)(3) of the California Constitution and that funds are being used for the purposes specified in the ballot language.
