# English Learner Program at Los Altos High School Proposal



#### **MVLA English Learning Program**

- Over the Years MVLA has concentrated its resources at one school site for our English Learners program.
- This gave a robust offering of courses and supports.
- We are seeing an increased need for English Learner support at both campuses.
- We are excited to expand the successful MVHS EL strategies, and use those "best practices" at LAHS.

#### **Motivations to this Proposal**

- Only MVHS provides English Learner (EL) courses for all levels of ELs.
- LAHS does not offer EL-specific courses.
  - Students who are EL and live in the LAHS Boundaries must attend MVHS to receive targeted EL services and classes.
  - Support classes are offered at LAHS but may not support targeted EL needs
  - Some EL students have decided to stay at LAHS without EL support.
- A typical LAHS EL student takes public transportation to MVHS. Some students require 60 minutes, one way, to get to and from school.
- Staff recommendation: Approve the addition of a minimum of ELD 1 4 classes, and other EL content courses (depending on enrollment) up to \$320,000 in funds. This program will grow according to identified student need, with more EL courses and supports.
