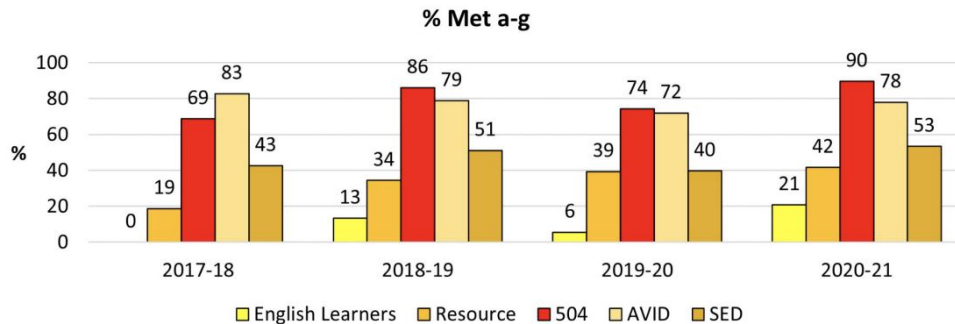
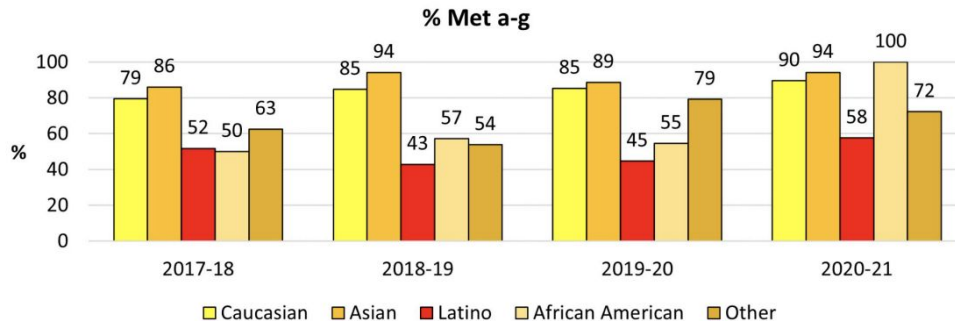


# Points of Pride

- AVID serves 7% of our total population. 90% of our AVID students identify as Latinx.
- (Less than 3% of the AVID students have IEP's)
- Should be noted 50% of Latinx students meeting A-G req **IS** an achievement
- (This is 15-20% higher than most districts)
- There was an increase in a-g achievement last year for all subgroups.
- Availability of robust preventative and responsive mental health and wellness services to support student needs

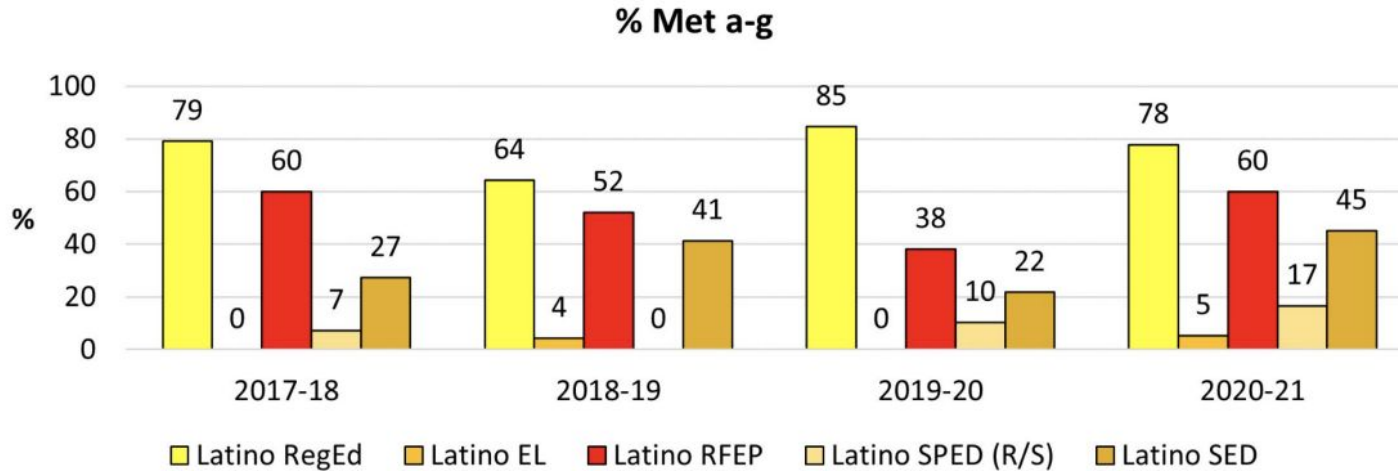

# Implementation and Monitoring of CCEIS Plans



## Plan 1-Target Group One

- Parent outreach every 4-5 weeks from staff
- Supporting quarter and semester deadline goals
- Two students received eyeglasses for support
- Parents able to get on Aeries with the support of Alma Ruelas
- One-to-one parent phone calls worked well for communication with staff from ELD, Supervised Study, and AVID departments.
- Goal is to improve academic achievement for this group by 5%**

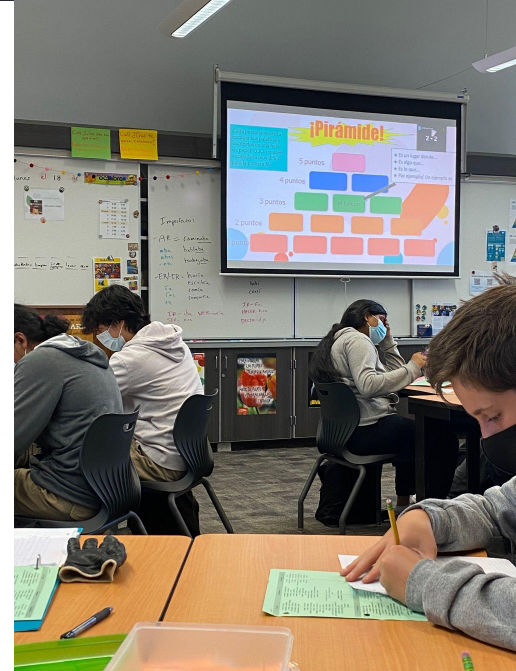
## Plan 2-Currently in Phase Two

# CCEIS Data



- ❑ Average GPA for Target Group June 2021-1.48
- ❑ Average GPA for Target Group October 2021-2.26
- ❑ Improvement in GPA from June to October-.78
- ❑ English Grade - 15 improved; 2 declined
- ❑ Math Grade - 22 improved; 1 declined
- ❑ Zero Suspensions
- ❑ Absences
  - ❑ 7 (Zero absences)
  - ❑ 17 (1-3 absences)
  - ❑ 8 (4-9 absences)
  - ❑ 2 (10-19 absences)
  - ❑ 1 (20+ absences)
- ❑ Referrals to Student Success Team = 3
- ❑ Referrals to Special Education = 1
- ❑ This is an improvement as we are taking a more systematic approach to identify supports for students that would reduce the need for a Special Education referral.



# Challenges and Support Needed

- Interventions to support students in general education: MTSS training for all staff (CCEIS identified need)
- Need to address increasing volume and acuity of mental health referrals
- Sharp increase in EL enrollment
- Identified critical need for credit recovery to meet post-pandemic learning needs
- Need to increase engagement of Latinx families within the MVHS community
