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

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
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Enrollment Trends 2023 - 2024 (Unduplicated)



Overall duplicated enrollment for 2023-2024 was 5189. Unduplicated enrollment by Adult Education Programs from 2022-2023 to 2023-2024 showed a decrease of nearly 12% in ESL due to changing demographic/proficiency level of students. There was a slight increase in ABE and GED enrollments, and a slight decrease in HSD enrollment. CTE enrollments increased by over 19%. Non-academic / feebased programs enrollment decreased by 5%.

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- Increased level completions Fourteen percent (14%) increase in level completions as measured by the CASAS STEPS reading test.
- Student Placement Placement process refined with additional interview and writing components improved initial student level placement accuracy.
- **Course Outlines** Updated course outlines for all 6 levels of ESL aligned with current NRS standards, English Language Proficiency Standards, and the California Immigrant Integration framework.
- **Instruction** Teachers learned to use new CASAS STEPS test reports to inform instruction.




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- Use English Language Proficiency Standards (ELPS) and leveled exit goals (writing, tech, academic vocabulary/reading) to update course outlines by June 2024.
- Updated course outlines for all six core ESL levels and citizenship completed in May 2024.
- Course outlines reflect current NRS standards and ELPS as well as the immigrant integration framework.
- Teaching strategies listed on outlines were collected in departmental meetings.


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ESL Outcomes 2023 - 2024



ESL completion percentages increased over 14% between 2022-2023 and 2023-2024. In 2023-2024, the program transitioned to the CASAS STEPS test which is more aligned with MVLA Adult School's current curriculum.


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High School Diploma/GED Highlights 2023 - 2024



• **Student Achievement** - More adult learners are choosing to pursue a GED over a HSD, as evidenced in higher number of enrollment in GED program and higher number of GED completers than in 2022-23.

- **Scholarships** The Los Altos Kiwanis Club and the Mountain View Rotary Club awarded two of our graduates with scholarships to continue their higher education at a local community college.
- 2024 Online Summer School 82% of students who enrolled in online summer school successfully completed their course.



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High School Diploma/GED Student Enrollment & Performance Data 2023 - 2024




ASE and ABE Unduplicated Enrollment


Enrollment in 2023-2024 slightly increased in GED and ABE but slightly decreased in HSD. Adult learners seem to prefer the GED program over a HSD as many have too many credits to make up under an adult HSD. The direct lessons and access to tutoring in GED classes provide more support and engagement than the blended HSD model.

From 2022-2023 to 2023-2024, there was a 57% increase in students earning a GED and a 33% decrease in students earning a high school diploma due to lower enrollment in the HSD program. NRS completion percentages have slightly increased over the past 3 years.



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
Concurrent, Moffett and YPP Unduplicated Enrollment

There was a decrease in the number of Moffetts and Concurrents referred over in the 2023-2024 school year. With the greater emphasis on GPA by the colleges, students are needing less remediation. The district continues to offer multiple ways for students to earn credits like VISP, Middle College, and College Now. ()

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


MVLA Adult School HS Seniors Who Earned Diplomas



Concurrent and Moffett completions refer to unduplicated high school seniors who completed at least one class at the Adult School in their final year. The number of Concurrent senior referrals in 2023-2024 decreased compared to the previous year due to less seniors who need to remediate an a-g course.

MVLA Adult School Online Summer School Data



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Of the 368 students who participated in online summer school, 82% of the students completed the course in summer 2024. The majority of students took Health and a small number extended their course into the 2nd summer session.

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Highlights (2023 - 2024)

IET MEDICAL TERMINOLOGY FOR ADVANCED ESL STUDENTS

- IET Medical Terminology for Advanced ESL Students has proven to be a valuable program.
- Those who have completed MRS, MA, or CNA programs are earning an average of \$27.84 per hour compared to the \$19.20 per hour minimum wage in Mountain View, CA.
- The highest earner, an ESL student from Germany, is now making \$50.00 per hour after being promoted from Medical Assistant (MA) to Surgical Technician.

TRANSITIONING TO HIGHER LEVELS IN CTE PROGRAMS

- MVLA Adult School provides language support and training, enabling students to transition into tuition-free entry CTE programs. These efforts have led to increased success, higher completion rates, and better earning potential.
- Graduates often secure employment directly from externship sites. A notable example is a student who advanced from Medical Assistant to Surgical Technician, earning \$50.00/hour, showcasing the program's impact.

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


- MA: Currently implementing the revised curriculum standards, and will evaluate the effectiveness of the updated curriculum.

- Full integration of FACETs into the CNA Morning program Google Classroom. Started the integration of the FACET's curriculum for CNA Evening program.

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
CTE Performance Data 2023 - 2024




CTE Enrollment by Industry Sectors 2023 - 2024



There was a significant percentage increase in Health Science and Medical Technology classes from the 2022 - 2023 school year to the 2023 - 2024 school year.






In 2023 - 2024, there was a 91-96% pass rate of students taking the Nationally Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) Written and Skills examination. CNA students scored 7% higher than the national average on both the written and skills examinations.

MVLA Medical Assistant (MA) Pass Rates Compared to National Pass Rates

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In 2023 - 2024, MA pass rates remained high in nationally certified examinations, far exceeding the national average.




TUTORING 2023 - 2024



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


