NEW CIF RULES



- Acclimatization period for all Fall sports
- Emergency Action Plans- must be specific by facility
- AEDs- will become required to be within 3 minutes of the athletic facility
- Wet Bulb- measures the heat in the air- more accurate reading of the **Heat Index**
- AQI- will be consistent across the state at 150 cancels matches/practices
