

Memorandum of Understanding
The El Camino YMCA (YMCA of Silicon Valley)
And
Mountain View/Los Altos High School District (MVLA)
Mountain View, CA

May 25th, 2022

The purpose of this document is to establish an agreement between the El Camino YMCA and the Mountain View Los Altos High School District (MVLA) relative to the use and programming of El Camino YMCA facilities for the Mountain View High School Alta Vista Opportunity (AV) & Post Senior (PS) Programs. This MOU will be in effect from August 10, 2022, through June 10, 2023 and is renewable for future academic school years upon mutual agreement between the YMCA and MVLA.

Program Objectives:

- Provide students/participants in both the Mountain View High School Alta Vista Opportunity Program and the Post Senior Program the opportunity to gain experience participating in health & wellness activities in a community environment with the goals of: improving their physical fitness, interacting with members of the community, learning new skills and increasing their independence.

El Camino YMCA

- The El Camino YMCA (“YMCA” herein) will provide full use of its facilities on Mondays and Thursdays (CLASS 1) 10 to 11:30 am (CLASS 2) 1:00-2:30pm , (CLASS 3) Monday and Tuesdays 1:00-2:30 pm . YMCA will give MVLA advanced notice of any gym use schedule changes due to YMCA programming (such as winter basketball) for the duration of the 2012-2023 school year (August 10, 2022 – June 10, 2023, excluding school holidays and breaks.) for up to 23 students total per week.
- The YMCA will work in conjunction with MVLA staff to implement an annual wellness orientation that will include goal setting and an overview of the safe use of the facilities and equipment including: court sports, group exercise, cardio and weight training (using strength training equipment).
- The YMCA will provide 1 staff member to instruct and lead the wellness orientation component of the program and to check in with the students/participants as needed during the year.
- The YMCA will provide MVLA a minimum of 10 days advanced notice, whenever possible, of any temporary changes to the schedule due to facility maintenance, emergency closures or other special circumstances.

- The YMCA agrees to maintain regular, open communication between MVLA program leads and YMCA staff in regards to facility use, challenges, successes, etc. with an overall goal of meeting the designated program outcomes and objectives. Such communication will include a minimum of quarterly check-ins.

Mountain View/Los Altos High School District

1. Students/Participants in the Mountain View Los Altos Union High School District Adult Transition Program will abide by all YMCA rules, policies and codes of conduct at all times while in the YMCA facility. Students/Participants who are in violation of these policies will be required to meet with YMCA staff to review proper conduct/use of the facility. Continued misconduct will result in removal from the program for either a designated period of time or permanently (to be determined in partnership by both YMCA staff and MVLA school personnel.)
2. Students/Participants will be chaperoned at all times by a minimum of three (3) MVLA staff including during use of YMCA locker rooms.

3. MVLA staff will supervise and facilitate the student/participant's activities while at the YMCA and will not utilize the time for personal workouts. MVLA staff are encouraged to participate alongside the students in the various activities as appropriate for the benefit of the students.
 4. No access to the El Camino YMCA will be made available for student/participants outside of the program scheduled days and times unless arranged and permitted in advance for special circumstances by the YMCA designated staff contact or if the student/participant has a separate YMCA membership.
 5. MVLA will provide an insurance endorsement naming the YMCA as "additional insured".
 6. MVLA agrees to pay an annual fee of \$14,000 for the program detailed herein.
- MVLA agrees to maintain regular, open communication between program leads and Y staff in regards to program design, challenges, successes, etc. with an overall goal of meeting the designated program outcomes and objectives. Such communication will include a minimum of quarterly check-ins.

The YMCA of Silicon Valley (YMCA) shall indemnify and hold harmless MVLA, including its officers, directors, employees and agents, from and against any and all liability, loss, damages and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees and costs, incurred by MVLA which arise out of or relate to the wrongful, willful, or negligent act or omission of MVLA, its officers, directors, employees or agents, in the performance of this Agreement.
