






## **Return in Mid-April**



## **Simultaneous Teaching**








## Safety and Mitigation Measures for Return

- 1. Face coverings
  - a. Students will wear masks at all times while on campus, except for eating & drinking
- 2. Distancing guidelines (3-feet) for classroom configuration
- 3. Ventilation:
  - Classrooms will be provided with fans, a clear plastic sneeze guard for teacher desk, MERV 13 filtration systems, CO2 monitors, windows and doors open (bring jacket if cold)
- 4. Hand hygiene
  - a. hand sanitizer in all rooms
  - b. hand washing stations throughout campus
- 5. Continued regular asymptomatic testing available
- 6. All non-staff and unauthorized students are prohibited from entering the campus
- 7. Custodial cleaning routines adjusted for in-person instruction per CDC guidelines
