ESSA Every Student Succeeds Act

With the enactment of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), California is streamlining local, state, and federal requirements into a single, coherent accountability and continuous improvement system.

Each part of the system aligns with the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) to support continuous learning and improvement, equity, and transparency.



The LCAP Addendum allows a district to complete a single plan (LCAP + Addendum + Consolidated Application for funding) to meet both state and federal requirements, align state and federal resources, and help minimize duplication of effort at the local level.



Local Control and Accountability Plan



The LCAP is the primary strategic planning document for each LEA

The LCAP is a tool for districts to set goals, plan actions, and leverage resources in consultation with stakeholders to improve student outcomes with specific activities to address Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) state and local priorities.

The LCAP describes how a district intends to meet annual goals for all students.

LCAP and Federal Addendum Connections The addendum and LCAP are both focused on the expenditure of district level funds.

The LCAP Federal Addendum is meant to supplement the LCAP to ensure that our district has the opportunity to meet the Plan provisions of the ESSA.
